

# Cosy Blanket for Toddlers

knitting pattern

**Size:** 1,16m x 1,14m | approx 45,7" x 44,9"  
(after blocking = approx 1,20m x 1,20m | 47,3" x 47,3")

## Required Material:

- Yarn** : Drops Merino extrafine (*Data provided by the manufacturer Drops: 100% wool, 50g = ca. 105m (approx 115 yds), Gauge 21 sts x 28 rows with needle size 4 (GER), 8 (UK), 6 (US) or a yarn of similar quality*)
- Consumption** : approx 700g (1470m) | 24,7oz (1608yds)  
= 150g (315m) | 5,3oz (344,5yds) blush (mix 45),  
150g (315m) | 6,3oz (344,5yds) desert rose (mix 46),  
400g (840m) | 14,1oz (918,6yds) sage green (mix 47)
- Gauge** : approx 18 stitches x 24 rows (stockinette stitch)
- Needle Size** : 5 (GER), 6 (UK), 8 (US) (or needle size required to achieve gauge)

## Instructions:

Cast on loosely 206sts using colour sage green (mix 47)

- Row 1:** (wrong side row) 1sst., \*p4, k4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with p4, 1sst.
- Row 2 - 39:** 1sst., \*k4, p4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with k4, 1sst.
- Row 40:** change colour to desert rose (mix 46), 1sst., \*k4, p4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with k4, 1sst.
- Row 41:** 1sst., \*p4, k4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end mit p4, 1sst.
- Row 42 - 43:** repeat rows 40 + 41
- Row 44:** change colour to sage green (mix 47), 1sst., \*k4, p4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with k4, 1sst.
- Row 45:** 1sst., \*p4, k4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with p4, 1sst.
- Row 46 - 47:** repeat rows 44 + 45
- Row 48 - 75:** work rows 40 - 47 (= till there are 5 stripes in desert rose (mix 46))
- Row 76:** change colour to sage green (mix 47), 1sst., \*k4, p4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with k4, 1sst.
- Row 77:** 1sst., \*p4, k4\*, repeat stitches between\*, end with p4, 1sst.
- Row 78 - 87:** repeat rows 76 + 77
- Row 88:** change colour to blush (mix 45), 1sst., \*k4, p4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with k4, 1sst.
- Row 89:** 1sst., \*p4, k4\*, repeat stitches between\*, end with p4, 1sst.
- Row 90 - 97:** repeat rows 88 + 89
- Row 98:** change colour to sage green (mix 47), 1sst., \*k4, p4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with k4, 1sst.
- Row 99:** 1sst., \*p4, k4\*, repeat stitches between\*, end with p4, 1sst.
- Row 100:** change colour to blush (mix 45), 1sst., \*k4, p4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with k4, sst.
- Row 101:** 1sst., \*p4, k4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with p4, 1sst.
- Row 102 - 109:** repeat rows 100 + 101
- Row 110:** change colour to sage green (mix 47), 1sst., \*k4, p4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with k4, 1sst.
- Row 111:** 1sst., \*p4, k4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with p4, 1sst.
- Row 112 - 121:** repeat rows 110 + 111
- Row 122:** change colour to desert rose (mix 46), 1sst., \*k4, p4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with k4, 1sst.
- Row 123:** 1sst., \*p4, k4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with p4, 1sst.
- Row 124 - 125:** repeat rows 122 + 123


Row 126: change colour to blush (mix 45), \*k4, p4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with k4, 1sst.  
 Row 127: 1sst., \*p4, k4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with p4, 1sst.  
 Row 128 - 129: repeat rows 126 + 127  
 Row 130 - 157: work rows 122 - 129 (= till there are 5 stripes in desert rose (mix 46))  
 Row 158: change colour to sage green (mix 47), 1sst., \*k4, p4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with k4, 1sst.  
 Row 159: 1sst., \*p4, k4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with p4, 1sst.  
 Row 160 - 169: repeat rows 158 + 159  
 Row 170: change colour to blush (mix 45), 1sst., \*k4, p4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with k4, 1sst.  
 Row 171: 1sst., \*p4, k4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with p4, 1sst.  
 Row 172 - 179: repeat rows 170 + 171  
 Row 180: change colour to sage green (mix 47), 1sst., \*k4, p4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with k4, 1sst.  
 Row 181: 1sst., \*p4, k4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with p4, 1sst.  
 Row 182: change colour to blush (mix 45), 1sst., \*k4, p4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with k4, 1sst.  
 Row 183: 1sst., \*p4, k4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with p4, 1sst.  
 Row 184 - 191: repeat rows 182 + 183  
 Row 192: change colour to sage green (mix 47), 1sst., \*k4, p4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with k4, 1sst.  
 Row 193: 1sst., \*p4, k4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with p4, 1sst.  
 Row 194 - 203: repeat rows 192 + 193  
 Row 204: change colour to desert rose (mix 46), 1sst., \*k4, p4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with k4, 1sst.  
 Row 205: 1sst., \*p4, k4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with p4, 1sst.  
 Row 206 - 207: repeat rows 204 + 205  
 Row 208: change colour to sage green (mix 47), 1sst., \*k4, p4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with k4, 1sst.  
 Row 209: 1sst., \*p4, k4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with p4, 1sst.  
 Row 210 - 211: repeat rows 208 + 209  
 Row 212 - 239: work rows 204 - 211 (= till there are 5 stripes in desert rose (mix 46))  
 Row 240: change colour to sage green (mix 47), 1sst., \*k4, p4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with k4, 1sst.  
 Row 241: 1sst., \*p4, k4\*, repeat stitches between \*, end with p4, 1sst.  
 Row 242 - 277: repeat rows 240 + 241  
 Row 278: bind off loosely

Weave in the remaining threads, wash, block and your cosy blanket is finished!

#### ABBREVIATIONS:

k = knit (k4 = knit 4 stitches), p = purl (p4 = purl 4 stitches), sst. = selvedge stitch

**TIP: Colour Change**  
Carry yarn between narrow stripes and start with new thread between wide stripes.
